

HAYWARD SATURDAY LEAGUE ROUND UP

Bournemouth Manor's impressive perfect league record, stretching back to the end of the 2014-15 season, was ruined when Elliott Cromarty's late equaliser earned nearest rivals Alderholt a 2-2 draw in the **HAYWARD SATURDAY PREMIER DIVISION**. The champions led with a first half goal from Dan Taylor but unbeaten Alderholt levelled after the break through Nathan Welch. Terry Foote looked to have settled the issue for Manor until Cromarty took advantage of a defensive mix up to earn the visitors a point.

Bournemouth Sports go second, a point adrift of Manor with a game in hand, after Ian Musselwhite struck twice to subdue Redlynch & Woodfalls United 2-1. Luke Charity was the Redlynch scorer.

Hamworthy Recreation move up to fourth place after Ed Ewens and Richard Preston clinched a 2-0 success against Bournemouth Electric and AFC Burton were also 2-0 winners when second half goals from Jamie Trimble and Dan Hancock accounted for Merley Cobham Sports.

In the other Premier Division game, goals from Brady Boontam, Craig Mowlam, and Daniel Wilson were not quite enough to save Parley Sports from a 4-3 defeat against Westover Bournemouth whose goals came via Kyle Leach (2) and Hamed Faal (2).
