Alex Whitehouse's late winner for *East Christchurch SSC* against previously unbeaten reigning DIVISION ONE champions *FC Hajduk* has thrown the title race wide open.

East Christchurch SSC, who have a date with their noisy neighbours East Christchurch Athletic in the Mark Hart Sunday Senior Cup Final at Hurn Bridge on Thursday night, emerged 3-2 winners and take over from FC Hajduk on top of the table.

FC Hajduk took an early lead courtesy of an own goal but Alex Whitehouse put SSC on terms ten minutes into the second half with a blistering effort from the edge of the penalty area. Will Hodge restored Hajduk's lead and Lewis Sainval hit the post after rounding the 'keeper.

Levi Ridealgh levelled the scores for SSC with a 35 yard free kick in the 75th minute and Alex Whitehouse made it 3-2 in the dying minutes of the game with a deflected strike into the top corner.

Kraken Sports are also very much in contention. They were 6-3 winners against East Christchurch Athletic on Wednesday night under the lights at Victoria Park thanks to Ocean Smith's hat-trick, a Max Wilcock brace, and a goal from substitute Tyler Rudd. Luke Churchill, Mickey Finch, and Jamie Morgan were the Athletic scorers.

Then, on Sunday, *Kraken Sports* were 5-1 winners against *Rushmere* through Max Wilcock, Dan Naish, Brad Hill, and a couple of goals from Tyler Rudd. Mike Sill scored Rushmere's consolation goal.

Pacesetters *Westover Bournemouth* returned to winning ways after two successive defeats in DIVISION TWO when Brady Devlin and Alex Henley accounted for *Muscliff* 2-0.
