KRAKEN SPORTS HAVE EYES ON THE PRIZE

Kraken Sports are closing in on the DIVISION ONE title after their emphatic 6-0 triumph over leaders *East Christchurch SSC* on Wednesday evening. Sonny Pike bagged the first of his brace after five minutes and Max Wilcock notched the first of his hat-trick two minutes later. Amechi Eze-Sunday was the other Kraken marksman with a 32nd minute strike.



On Sunday *Kraken* drew 0-0 with reigning champions *FC Hajduk* and they now need three points from their remaining two games to clinch the title.

But their focus now shifts to the BDFA Camerons Cup Final on Thursday night at Hurn Bridge (7.30 pm kick off) when they meet Division Three giant killers *Parkstone Club*.

RAMPANT RANGERS ARE ALMOST THERE

DIVISION TWO leaders *New Forest Rangers* were 8-3 winners against *Bourne* on Wednesday evening thanks to Josh Stoodley's hat-trick and further goals from Jack Delves, Stephen Pryor, and substitute George Deem. Harvey Boothby, Matt Lock, and substitute Dan Richards were the Bourne scorers.

Stephen Pryor and Leon Collins both bagged hat-tricks when *Rangers* hammered *West Howe* 8-2 on Sunday morning with Reuben Stanley getting the other two. Manny Ohameje and Louie Louka were the West Howe scorers.

With nearest rivals *Westover Bournemouth* going down 4-3 to third placed *Bourne* leaving Rangers six points clear, needing just a point from their two remaining games to take the title. Alessandro Di Marco notched a hat-trick for Bourne with Lewis Cannings also on target while Westover replied through Elliott Lines and a couple of goals from Morgan Hyam.

Rob Vining scored *New Milton Town's* second half winner in their 2-1 midweek success against *AFC Burton*. Rhys Jessop was the other New Milton marksman with Luke Barnett replying for the visitors.

AFC Burton went down again on Sunday when *Muscliff* upended them 3-1 through Morgan Jackson and Bailey Hibbs. Tom Jackson was the Burton scorer.

Woodville Wanderers clinched the DIVISION THREE title on Wednesday evening when they completed their campaign with a 4-2 success against nearest rival *Bournemouth Athletic*. Tolulope Adesoji capitalised on a defensive slip to give Athletic a first minute lead but the Badgers came back through Jordan Coltman, Matt

Kerse, Mike Kitson and Christian Bond before Michael Power pulled one back for Athletic in the dying minutes.
